

## New Life for Old Churches

Studies show that the vast majority of churches in the United States are in a state of decline. Many older churches have members who remember the “glory days” back when there were large numbers of children in Sunday school and extra chairs set up in the sanctuary for Easter and Christmas services. Some of these same churches now have meetings during which the leaders spend most of their time discussing how to pay for repairs on an aging building and whether the church will even survive into the future.

## Our Speaker



**Rev. Jim Barnes** currently serves as the National Minister of the Evangelical Association of Reformed and Congregational Christian Churches, a nationwide network of congregations and pastors committed to the authority of Scripture, classic Christian orthodoxy and the advancement of the Kingdom.

Prior to his appointment, Jim was a local church pastor for 24 years during which time he led a century old German Evangelical church through a season of biblical renewal. Over a period of two decades, the church went from having less than 5% of the adults in the church involved in regular Bible study to more than 50%. Small groups were introduced into the life of the congregation and the budget of the church more than tripled while the support of missionaries multiplied tenfold. Throughout his entire ministry career, Jim has had a passion to see old churches reformed, renewed and revitalized.
